

## APPLICATION FOR APPOINTMENT TO THE BOSCAWEN AGRICULTURAL COMMISSION

## This commission operates under the authority of, and appointment by, the Board of Selectmen.

The select board shall appoint 5-7 members that will be a representation of all types of residents.

The term of these appointed members shall be staggered and shall be for three years except when the appointment is made to fill out an unexpired term. Agricultural Commission members may not be employees of the Town.

When there is a vacancy, the Board shall advertise and invite qualified persons to submit a letter of interest. The Board of Selectmen and two appointed Agricultural Commission members shall act as a committee to review the applications and recommend persons to fill the vacant position(s). Criteria for selection shall be the persons who best represent the community, who are willing to attend meetings and work to meet the vision and objectives of the Town of Boscawen and its Agricultural Commission.

The Agricultural Commission, upon its convening annually, shall elect a chairperson and vice chairperson.

Eligibility for the Agricultural Commission:

- I. Live within the Town of Boscawen, more than 6 months of the year
- 2. Be a registered voter
- 3. Not be an employee of the Town
