DIRECTIONS:

From I-93: Take Exit 17 and bear right off the ramp. Follow Rte 4 to the traffic circle and take the second ramp in the circle to Harris Hill Road for 0.2 miles, turn left onto Tackson Street for 0.4 miles and arrive at the Boscawen Complex on the right. From Rtes 3 and 4 southbound through Boscawen: Turn right at the traffic light onto N. Main Street (Route 3 South). Shortly after Alan's Restaurant (on right), is the Boscawen Municipal Complex (on left). Turn left onto **Jackson Street** and left into the parking lot.
