Dear Water Customer:

The Penacook-Boscawen Water Precinct has contracted with Water System Operator, Inc. to provide the required operation and assure that all the system reports will be submitted on a timely basis to the New Hampshire Department of Environmental Services.

The Penacook-Boscawen Water Precinct recently received a notice of violation of a drinking water monitoring requirement. Although this is not an emergency, as our customers, you have a right to know what happened and what we are doing to correct the situation.

During the Third Quarter of 2017, we did not complete the submittal of all reporting for chlorine residual and therefore cannot be sure of the quality of your drinking water during that time.

We are required to monitor your drinking water for specific contaminants on a regular basis. Results of regular monitoring are an indicator of whether or not your drinking water meets health standards. There is nothing you need to do at this time.
