

APPLICATION FOR APPOINTMENT TO THE BOSCAWEN OLD HOME DAY COMMITTEE

This commission operates under the authority of, and appointment by, the Select Board

The Select Board shall appoint 5-7 commissioners and 3-5 alternates that will be a representation of all types of residents.

The term of these appointed commissioners and alternates shall be staggered and shall be for three years except when the appointment is made to fill out an unexpired term. Old Home Day Committee members may not be employees of the Town.

When there is a vacancy, the Board shall advertise and invite qualified persons to submit a letter of interest. The Select Board and two appointed Old Home Day Committee members (only after the committee is established) shall act as a committee to review the applications and recommend persons to fill the vacant position(s). Criteria for selection shall be the persons who best represent the community, who are willing to attend meetings and work to meet the vision and objectives of the Town of Boscawen and its Old Home Day Committee.

The Old Home Committee, upon its convening annually, shall elect a chairperson and vice chairperson.

Eligibility for the Old Home Day Committee:

- I. Live within the Town of Boscawen, more than 6 months of the year
- 2. Be a registered voter
- 3. Not be an employee of the Town
