- Chairman Crawford opened the Public Hearing on the Master Plan at 8:23pm.
- o <u>Transportation</u>
- 39 Chairman Crawford asked the Board if they had input. Mark Varney commented that he thinks
- 40 it's great the way it's currently written. Brian Fleury noted content and grammatical errors in
- 41 the section. Page 3: last paragraph regarding the 'recommendations incorporated in both
- studies' there is a grammatical error. Mr. Fleury mentioned he would skip over the rest of the
- 43 grammatical errors and focus on content. Page 4: bottom of the page Boscawen interim
- improvements 2017-2016. Should that say 2018? Mark Varney noted we needed to clarify the
- 45 paragraph because we don't budget for the corridor improvements. Mark suggested printing
- out a copy with the errors and getting it to Kellee to fix the errors. Chairman Crawford tabled
- 47 the Transportation section until next month to allow for corrections.
 - Motion made by Mark Varney, and seconded by Matt Lampron, to table the Transportation
- 49 section until the April meeting. All in favor.
 - Energy
- 51 Chairman Crawford mentioned there is a lot of content within this section that he isn't sure we
- 52 can do anything about. Rhoda Hardy mentioned that Boscawen was spelled incorrectly on page
- 11. Kellee Jo Easler had sent this document to Edward Cherian, Jr. to review. He made
- corrections to the section and they were incorporated. Mrs. Hardy stated that on page 7 only
- 55 half of the 'draft' watermark came off. Alan Hardy said that if spelling errors are found after
- the document is approved that is a non-substantive change and they will be corrected on an
- ongoing basis. Brian Fleury said from a public point of view it gets confusing when there is a
- 58 typo because you're not sure what you're actually reading. Chairman Crawford said it's
- important that years from now someone reading it be able to understand what was meant.

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60 61 62	Mrs. Hardy mentioned there could be an error on the middle of the last paragraph where is says: 'The link between energy and transportation is a strong one'. She recommended looking at that part again. Chairman Crawford noted there were a lot of run on paragraphs.
63 64	Motion made by James Scrivens, and seconded by Mark Varney, to approve the Energy section of the Master Plan pending proof-reading. All in favor.

66 67 68 69	Chairman Crawford said this section is primarily statistics. It was noted that most of the statistics came from the school and the census data. The census information is from 2010. Mr. Hardy noted that on page 2 – 'the office of strategic initiatives' at the bottom of the second paragraph. The word 'strategic' needs to be capitalized.
70 71	Motion made by Rhoda Hardy, and seconded by Barbara Randall, to approve the Population & Demographics section of the Master Plan. All in favor.
72 73 74 75 76 77	James Scrivens had a question regarding this section. He noted the medium income for Boscawen is less than the surrounding towns. He wanted to know if that's because the Merrimack County Nursing Home residents are residents of Boscawen and their income is reflected in those numbers. Mrs. Hardy noted they are part of our population count. Mrs. Easler said they are allowed to vote in the Town. The Correctional facility members don't vote, but Alan isn't certain that the new treatment facility will be the same way. Mr. Varney said the individuals housed in the treatment facility are still inmates. Discussion ensued.
79 80 81 82	Board members noted that they didn't have the same version of the documents. Discussion ensued regarding which member had which documents. It was decided to rescind the approval until members have accurate documentation. Mr. Hardy said they will get the current document from Central NH Regional Planning Commission.
