Meeting Minutes – Final
January 15, 2019

Barbara Randall called the meeting to order at 6:02pm.

In attendance: Lt. Killary, Kevin Sullivan, Paul Dickey, Barbara Randall, Lorrie Carey and Selectman Mark Varney

Selectman Varney made a motion to accept the minutes from the previous meeting. Seconded by Kevin Sullivan. All were in favor.

Lt. Killary reported the new cruiser is on the road and that all vehicles are currently in good shape. Both the annual Halloween Party and Christmas for Kids program were very successful this past year.

The committee was presented with an Activity Report dated mid-October through the first of the year, depicting notable incidents/arrests. Discussion ensued.

Officer Chislett has attended LEAD (Law Enforcement Against Drugs) training and will be able to work with Boscawen Elementary students next year. The department received a grant to fund this training. Going forward the department hopes to have more officers attend this training.

People may have noticed an increase of blue lights along our roads and streets. The police department wants to send a serious message: Don't speed or do illegal acts in Boscawen! They have been dealing with many issues and are hoping the extra presence will deter future problems.
