

APPLICATION FOR APPOINTMENT TO THE BOSCAWEN ADVISORY BUDGET COMMITTEE

This committee operates under the authority of, and appointment by, the Board of Selectmen.

The select board must appoint 7 members that will be a representation of all types of residents.

The term of these appointed members shall be staggered and shall be for three years except when the appointment is made to fill out an unexpired term. Budget committee members may not be employees of the Town.

When there is a vacancy, the Board shall advertise and invite qualified persons to submit a letter of interest. The Board of Selectmen and two appointed budget committee members shall act as a committee to review the applications and recommend persons to fill the vacant budget committee position(s). Criteria for selection shall be the persons who best represent the community, who are willing to attend meetings and work to meet the vision and objectives of the Town of Boscawen.

The advisory budget committee, upon its convening annually, shall appoint a chairperson, vice chairperson and a secretary.

Eligibility for the Budget Committee:

- I. Live within the Town of Boscawen, 6 months of the year
- 2. Be a registered voter
- 3. Not be an employee of the Town
